Abstract

Losing migrants and refugees' talents because of our inoperability will be our responsibility. Migrants and refugees are said¹ to be "a tremendous added social, economic and political value". Who are the most appropriate to detect and channel their specific needs on tertiary education? Universities should ask NGOs in order to identify training needs and design programs and evaluation systems relative to this vulnerable and valued collective.

This workshop sets out the Spanish Refugee Aid Commission (CEAR), a representative voice of migrants and refugees in Spain, and HERMES, an old UNED project set up for special learning and teaching of migrants and refugees in which CEAR is interested in participating, channelling their voices.
